Editorial

After a few warm weeks away in Sri Lanka and KL there was no doubt an election is looming as we drove back from the airport. The dreaded election signs are up all around, apart from in Leigh where most have already been vandalised. Love them or hate them it means we have to think about voting.

There is something of a message in the US election result where 50% of those eligible didn't vote and 25% of American inflicted Donald Trump on the world. Yet this was a democratic election in arguably the world's greatest democracy. There has been a huge amount of moaning about the result and no doubt some comes from those who didn't vote.

New Zealand needs a government for the next three years and with MMP we do get more of a choice than the US. There is no valid reason for not voting. My vote has swung almost every direction over more than 40 years of voting. In some cases I have voted against my party of choice where the sitting MP is doing a good job. The reverse is also true where the sitting MP is not.

With MMP we can vote for a completely different party to the local electorate. And there is also a vote for a minor party if you believe in something specific they are pushing for. Under MMP they may be the difference between governing and not governing.

The main thing is to get out there and vote. If you don't you have no right to complain about the result and who is going to run the country. You don't have the right to damage the election hoardings either.


Join the frenzy! Agapanthus is going! How fantastic it is to walk around Leigh and Matheson Bay and see the huge clearances being made. Around Leigh the agapanthus clearance is mostly on private property while in Matheson Bay it is due to groups of committed locals who have



working bees to clear the agapanthus from road side drains and house frontages. It is a highly invasive plant, and for our Coast Care Group, it is wonderful to see it going, before any more of it gets into the bush.

It is also really heartening to hear reports of rat/stoat catches by residents who attended the Leigh pest eradication workshops last year. Fantastic all those who are keeping the trapping going, and also the systematic trapping work undertaken by the Leigh Harbour Valley Society. Imagine if everyone was doing it! What we could achieve!

Scientific evidence is accumulating to show that penguin populations in the

100 YEARS AGO- AUGUST 1917

The Ti Point wharf had collapsed. The settlers decided local action was needed and they would provide the labour to build a new wharf. They asked the Council to write to the Public Works Department "strongly urging them to sanction the expenditure of £100" that had been voted for the repair of the Ti Point Wharf some years previously.

The cost of carrying parcels on the Northern Steamship Co. steamers trading with Warkworth had been set at: parcels up to one foot, 6d; large parcels 1s and 1s 3d according to size; parcels of bread and meat, 6d.

The Rodney and Otamatea Times, 8 August reported they were pleased to notice that "Sqt. J.E.C.(Eddie Wyatt) eldest son of Mr J.C. Wyatt of Leigh, who has been serving in Egypt, has been nominated for training for a commission in the NZEF" (New Zealand Expeditionary Forces). Eddie studied at Oxford University, England and graduated as an Officer.



Leigh Volunteer Fire Brigade

Leigh brigade's members attended 10 callouts during July. These were a motor vehicle accident at Tawharanui, a power line down at Matakana and a false alarm at Matakana. The other calls were first response medicals to Leigh (5), Matheson Bay and Whangateau.

You may have been aware of an increase in the number of fire trucks around the Leigh area recently. This is due to a few members of the brigade undergoing emergency driver training in order to bring the brigade's number of drivers up.

At the end of training which involved dring under the watch of an instructor for four days, Kevin Lawton, Tony Enderby, Errol Murray, Nick Torkington and Malcolm Allen are all now qualified as emergency response drivers.

A worrying trend is the increased number of house fires around New Zealand with fatal results. Smoke alarms do work and it would be great to see every house in Leigh fitted with one. The worst possible scenario for the Leigh brigade team would be to have to attend a fatal house fire. If you don't have a smoke detector or think yours doesn't work, contact Tony on 422 6127.

It's nice to see the days getting longer again although the weather is still definitely winter. Brigade members have continued training on various emergency scenarios that hopefully they won't have to put into practice. Our numbers have increased a bit at the moment but if you are interested in joining the brigade drop down on a Tuesday night at 7pm and have a chat to one of us.


