RATES REBATE

Are you entitled to an Auckland Council rates rebate?

Here are some examples of what you could get from applying for a tax rebate from Auckland Council if you are eligible:

Rates	Earnings	Rebate
\$2000	\$25000-\$35000	\$640-\$60
\$2400	\$25000-\$37000	\$640-\$76
\$3000	\$25000-\$40000	\$640-\$101

You have until 30 June, 2020 to apply for this year's rebate but don't delay it, start now by getting a Rates Rebate Application Form. Fill in the details including your income and rates. Get it signed by a JP or other authorised person and post. Any rebate will come off your next Auckland Council invoice.

PEST FREE LEIGH

To keep children and pets safe, rat and stoat traps should be placed inside wooden tunnels. You can make your own by using scrap wood. Check out your garage/shed or ask friends or builders if they have any scrap wood suitable for building tunnels. Planks of fencing timber 150mm x 25mm x 500mm would be suitable to use. You can also use marine grade ply treated timber and cut it to suit.

The width depends on the size of your rat trap but you should also consider the width of the wire mesh that can be inserted into a slot in the wooden sides. Another way for the wire mesh if the top and sides are even, is to use screws or nails at the bottom to act like a hinge and another at the top to hold the mesh on with a nail that can be removed when checking your rat trap.

If your tunnel is a bit rough looking, I'm sure the lure of peanut butter will still attract the rats.

New Non-Emergency Number - 105

The launch of 105 marks a very significant milestone in the history of New Zealand Police. They made a song, featuring staff, to help you get it stuck in your head. You might have noticed their awesome video promoting the new way to contact police for non-emergencies, 105.

Until now people either called their local police station or they called 111 if they wanted to get hold of Police. Quite often people called 111 just because they wanted to talk to someone even if the matter wasn't urgent.

To keep New Zealand as safe as possible, they have introduced 105 so people know how to contact police for non-urgent situations. You can use 105 to report things that have already happened that don't need urgent Police assistance.

You can call 105 from both mobile and landline phones. It's a free nationwide service available day and night for New Zealanders and overseas visitors.

You can also go online to 105.police.govt.nz to report: Theft in a public place -Theft from a car - Intentional property damage - Shoplifting - Lost property or to get an update on a report already made or add to an existing report.

Just remember to always call 111 in an emergency. The new 105 service is only for Police non-emergencies. Call 111 when:- A crime is happening now – and the offenders are still there or just left -Someone's in danger or badly injured -There's a serious risk to human life or property - You see a major public hazard, like trees blocking a road - Any of these things are happening now or have just happened.111 is also the number for Fire and Ambulance. A simple rule of thumb for when to call 111 and when to call 105 is this: If it's happening now, use 111. If it's already happened, use 105.

JOINING THE DOTS

Earlier this month the Forest Bridge Trust had a community workshop to map out a pathway for birds, lizards etc — from Tawharanui to Tamahunga. Amazingly, more than 150 people came to listen to the research and give their ideas about which bits of the natural environment should be included in the corridor—whether pubic land or private, covenanted or not.

The same issue exists for Leigh. The more we can connect and protect areas of natural bush, the better it will be for our native wildlife. The workshop highlighted how important it is for people to remove pest plants, and remove animal predators from their land. It also highlighted how many wonderful private citizens are doing just that; seeing the bigger picture of everyone working together to restore our environment. It is needing the help of everyone more urgently than ever before.

The drains in and around Matheson Bay are being cleaned out and those that have been done are sporting a bright yellow dot.

The installing of anti-slip mesh on boardwalks in the Kohuroa stream track has been completed and a successful clearing of weeds surrounding the new planting in the reserve was well attended. Council came to the party with a large green waste bag which they collect. This is a great help for volunteer groups with weeding, as disposal is costly. The plants are thriving and more will be planted in the future.

Two hardy swimmers are enjoying the 15deg. temperatures in the bay and us dog walkers are more than happy to cheer them on from the side lines each morning.

I, and several people from Leigh, attended the Forest Bridge Trust workshop held in Matakana recently. This is an exciting program that is aiming at creating bush corridors connecting Mangawhai in the east to the Kaipara Harbour in the west. The trust is encouraging and helping land owners and groups with protection, planting and pest control. Our area, although not part of a major group, has three small groups as well as individuals trapping from Ti Point to Goat Island which is a great start.

One group is working towards trapping along the coast from Ti Point to help with nesting little blue penguins. Council will be running some training in trap and bait setting in the coming weeks. It has been decided that no poison will be used in this area. For more information on The Forest Bridge Trust check out their website on **www.theforestbridgetrust.org.nz** We are very fortunate to have Little Barrier so close and as removal of animal pests progresses more bird life will settle in the area.

Leigh Volunteer Fire Brigade

One thing about fire brigade callouts is the inconsistency of them. July started with five callouts in the first two weeks then there were no further callouts for a month. July's callouts were to a scrub fire at Whangateau with the others all medical calls to Leigh, Ti Point, Goat Island and Whangateau. Over the past month our crew have all completed the First responder Refresher courses run by St John Ambulance trainers. To keep this level we need to spend a full day training every six months. This means we are able to provide a higher level of support to a patient before the ambulance arrives.

With the ambulances attending more and more calls there is often a major delay or the ambulance is diverted to a more serious call. Our crews are now often in attendance at medical calls for over an hour.

Remember that we are volunteers and give up working time to attend calls. If you are on scene or have called an ambulance for a family member or a

We are called by St John to all medical calls so if you see a fire truck arrive instead of the expected ambulance please treat our team as you would the ambulance staff. I know that almost all locals already do this.

Now the days are getting longer we will have more training time outside on Tuesday nights. If you think you may be interested in becoming a firefighter, come along to the fire station at 7pm on a Tuesday night.
