PREDATOR FREE LEIGH

An initial meeting to discuss how Leigh could become a pest free community was hosted by Leigh Central on 4 December 2019. The meeting brought together those who are already engaged in trapping for predators and others with an interest in improving our environment.

Leigh is a potential habitat for many native species including birds, reptiles and invertebrates many of which are uncommon or threatened. Our proximity to Hauturu makes Leigh and surrounding area a first stepping stone for their dispersal onto the mainland. It is important Leigh is predator controlled so that birds can survive here to disperse further inland.

Target species for predator control are rats, possums and mustelids in line with Predator Free 2050 targets. There is already great work being done within the area by individual groups (Leigh Harbour Valley Society; Penguin Project; Goat Island and coastal track group; together with trapping groups in Matheson Bay and Whangateau)- but their efforts will be limited by continual reinvasion if there is no co-ordinated approach.

The project plans to support co-ordination between these existing efforts and focus on a new project in the Leigh / Matheson Bay township.. We are looking for active engagement from the whole community – young and old, permanent residents and holiday home owners, urban and rural. We want to beat that 2050 goal!

As the project develops through 2020 we will be presenting to the community how each individual landowner can contribute but for now we would be really interested in hearing from anyone who can help establish the project.

We need help: making trap boxes; establishing trap lines and laying traps; promotion and publicity (esp social media); and financial contributions for traps and bait. We are especially looking for a co-ordinator who has the time and energy to get this project off the ground.

BLUE IRIS. PLEASE REMOVE!

Blue Iris/Aristea has recently arrived in Leigh. It grows anywhere, invading bush margins, open grasslands, even lawns! Blue Iris forms a tight mass which

blocks out other plants. Please look for it as it must be removed before the seeds set- usually about now.

What does it look like? It has swordlike leaves, like a smaller version of the common garden iris but often brighter green, and grows about 40cm high. Its' pretty little deep blue flowers appear in bright sun.

What should I do? Dig it out and either dispose of it with your refuse, or deep bury it. See Weedbusters website for more info.



Then And Now

Bethea Frost, who recently passed away, wrote a little history book called Leigh Then and Now. In the preface of the book Beth talks about how she had to check and recheck the information from the diaries of Mr Charles Septimus Clarke. She visited libraries, archives and museums, wrote numerous letters and looked through many papers.

She put together a book which she hoped would be interesting, on the lives of the early settlers, their schools in the area and the progress made from then to the time the book was produced. Quite a few other locals also helped Beth to

write some of the early history and lent papers and photographs. Beth was able to view copies of letters written to the local paper from 1875 to 1881, copies of early school committee minutes and cuttings about early people.

This little 88-page green book is available at Leigh Library for those interested in learning a bit more about Leigh's history

Leigh Penguin Project

Forest & Bird Warkworth Area Little Blue Penguin / Kororā (Ti Point to Goat Island)

About this time last year our group had completed our Health & Safety Policy, worked on a community agreement, purchased rat traps using a donation from the Leigh Community Club and had boxes for rat traps being made by Arthur Gundy. It is inspiring to think about what we have achieved since then.

Over 45 penguin nesting boxes have been placed around the coast.

A trapline has been set up from Wonderview to Penguin St. (73 rats, weasels and mice have been caught).

Monitoring of pests using ink cards has been completed twice (6 monthly) at Ti Point.

Rodney Local Board have provided advice and traps for the Ti Point Coastal Walkway. (84 possums, rats, weasels and mice have been caught).

Results of predators caught have been added to the Catch IT website.

Application for the DoC Community Fund has been successful.

A dog specialising in seabirds has explored Ti Point and over 16 nesting sites of little penguins was noted.

More traps have been purchased and wooden boxes for them are being made as we plan to add another trapline alongside the Leigh Harbour Walkway.

Many thanks to all the volunteers who have worked on paperwork, checked traplines, carried traps to sites, helped with monitoring using ink cards, recorded catches, made trap boxes and checked penguin boxes. You are making a real difference to our native flora and fauna. Many thanks also to the Rodney Local Board and the Department of Conservation for their help with our project.

Leigh Fire Brigade attended 10 callouts during November which was a little busier than the previous month. Two calls were false alarms at Matakana and there were scrub fires at Leigh (3), Snells Beach, Matakana, and Point Wells, some of these being fireworks related. The other calls were to a structure fire on Pakiri Hill and a medical call to Leigh.

Santa will be doing his traditional fire truck run on Christmas Eve starting from Whangateau around 5pm and working back to Leigh. Listen for the siren and the "ho ho ho"!

It looks like being a dry summer and we have already attended quite a few vegetation fires which started in rubbish burnoffs. Take care with any fire – and remember you need a permit for any outdoor fire at the moment. If there is little rain this may change to a notified complete fire ban
